Commissioner Hensler read the following announcement:

The Office of Community Development (OCD), recently completed review of 10 Neighborhood Revitalization and 26 Critical Infrastructure applications for the PY 2021 Community Development Program. The requests totaled \$18,939,500. OCD thoroughly reviewed the proposals according to the guidelines outlined in the PY2021 Ohio Consolidated Plan Annual Action Plan. Upon completion of the review process, 18 applicans will be awarded 24 projects totaling \$13,427,100 in Community Development Block Grant(CDBG) dollars.

**Jackson County will be awarded \$750,000.00 for its Neighborhood Revitalization project in Oak Hill Village. Jackson County will also be awarded \$500,000.00 for its Critical Infrastructure sanitary sewer project in Jackson City.**
