JFS Director Tammy Osborne-Smith and JFS Senior Leadership Loree Walker were present to give quarterly updates regarding Job & Family Services. Ms. Osborne-Smith mentioned the Open House at JFS in October stating it was a good turnout and positive response. The community baby shower was held in August and JFS served over 400 kids. Ms. Walker spoke of “Connect Ohio”, which they are one of only 15 counties at this point involved with Connect, whose focus is Family Search and Engagement, where their specialist has 30-45 days to make 80 contacts for that child with some type of family member. Federal public health emergency regarding Medicaid is still ongoing. Ms. Osborne-Smith also stated that for the first time in 4 years, they will be fully staffed in child protection, and she gave the commissioners the “monthly snapshot report”, which covers all of the JFS services available. JFS averages between 100-111 kids in foster care monthly.
