The Commissioners thanked Ms. Riegel for her many years of service, and stated that due to all her hard work, public transportation may finally come to fruition for Jackson County. Ms. Riegel's last official day will be May 31, 2023.

**Bonnie Ward**, Governor Dewine's southeast region liaison, **Kelly Johnson** with Senator Vance's office and **Julie Stephens**, field representative for Congressman Wenstrup's office, were present to give updates from their prospective offices, as well as receive updates from the commissioners. Commissioner Willis stated that Jackson County received \$1,000,000.00 of the state grant awarded from the Ohio Jail Safety and Security Program, for a feasibility study for a new jail that could serve Jackson County and the surrounding region. CASC is part of this multi-faceted approach. Ms. Ward stated that Governor Dewine has been visiting schools and pushing the importance of phonics. Ms. Johnson stated that Senator Vance spent a lot of time in East Palastine regarding the train derailment. Senator Vance is on the following committees: Banking, Housing & Urban Affairs, Commerce, Science & Transportation, Joint Economic Development & Special Committee on Aging. Ms. Stephens stated that Congressman Wenstrup is chair on the Coronovirus Sub-committee, which is studying the origin of the virus, as well as all the effects that it, as well as the vaccines, have had on American people. Congressman Wenstrup is also the 3<sup>rd</sup> most effective congressman on legislation.
