Matt Hammond(Executive Director) and Missy Walters(Outreach Coordinator), with the Empowerment Alliance, which is an organization trying to energize Ohioans about the energy issue, were present to discuss TEA's Four Pillars of American Energy Independence: a)Affordable Energy for our Families b)Clean Energy for our environment c)Abundant Energy for our future and d)American Energy for our security.
