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EMS HR Director Tim Jackson presented a retroactive proclamation regarding the Ohio Ambulance Transportation and Impacted Industry Grants, in which the emergency medical services received grant funding for the Ohio Ambulance Transportation in the amount of \$20,845.54 awarded on July 23, 2023, which was awarded to the EMS employees that provided direct patient care during the Covid Pandemic at the set rate by Ohio EMA. EMS also received grant funding for the Ohio Impacted Industry in the amount of \$103,049 awarded on July 24, 2024, awarding each employee 10% of their salary during the peek Covid timeframe. Both of these grants were closed after payment. This proclamation was the last thing requested by the Ohio State Auditor, who is auditing the Ohio EMA.

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Jackson County EMS also received the BWC Safety Grant for \$40,000.00 (EMS portion will be \$14,000.00) and will purchase Stryker Powered Stair Chairs and they will be delivered in 6 weeks.

Mr. Jackson also stated that Jackson County EMS received the 2025 Mission Lifeline Gold Award for EMS from the American Heart Association for excellence in heart attack and stroke care. In 2025 Jackson County EMS surpassed the standard and were awarded the Gold Award. 2025 is the first year that EMS has received the highest award possible.
